English

This half term we will be getting our passports ready and jet setting off to Australia (in the comfort of our classroom). We'll be basing our fact and fiction writing on stories such as 'The Koala Who Could' and writing information pages all about Australian animals!



Maths

This half term the children will be challenged and extended as they move towards understanding the link between multiplication and division. We will be measuring and monitoring temperatures both at home and aboard as we compare hot and cold climates.

Science

We will continue our jigsaw learning with looking at relationships both at home and in school and how they can look different.
